



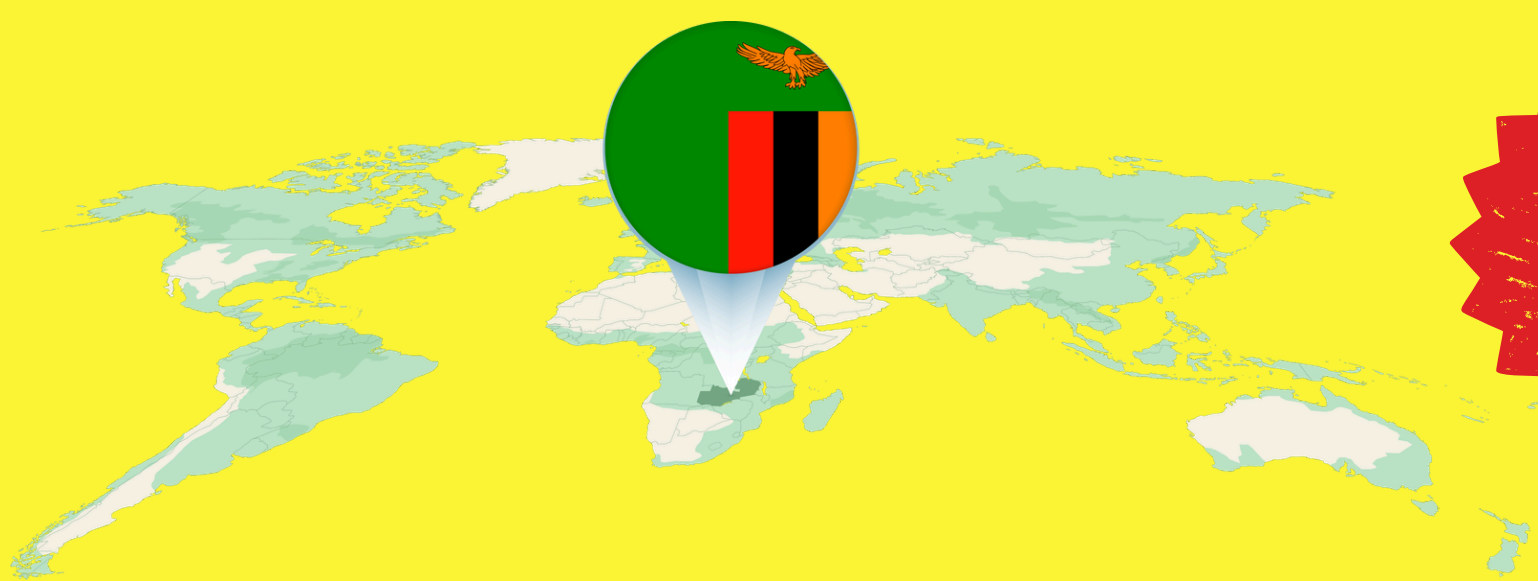
Our Rainbow House Project Update & Rotary Partnership Report

Our Rainbow House is an Australian and Zambian registered charity providing education and nutrition to orphans and vulnerable children in Chainda, on the outskirts of Lusaka, Zambia.

Founded 14 years ago, the project was created to give children a safe place to learn and grow with hope for the future. Today, the school delivers education under the Zambian National Curriculum while supporting students, families, and the wider community. Students learn in a safe and nurturing environment and receive two meals each school day, along with essential support during school holidays.

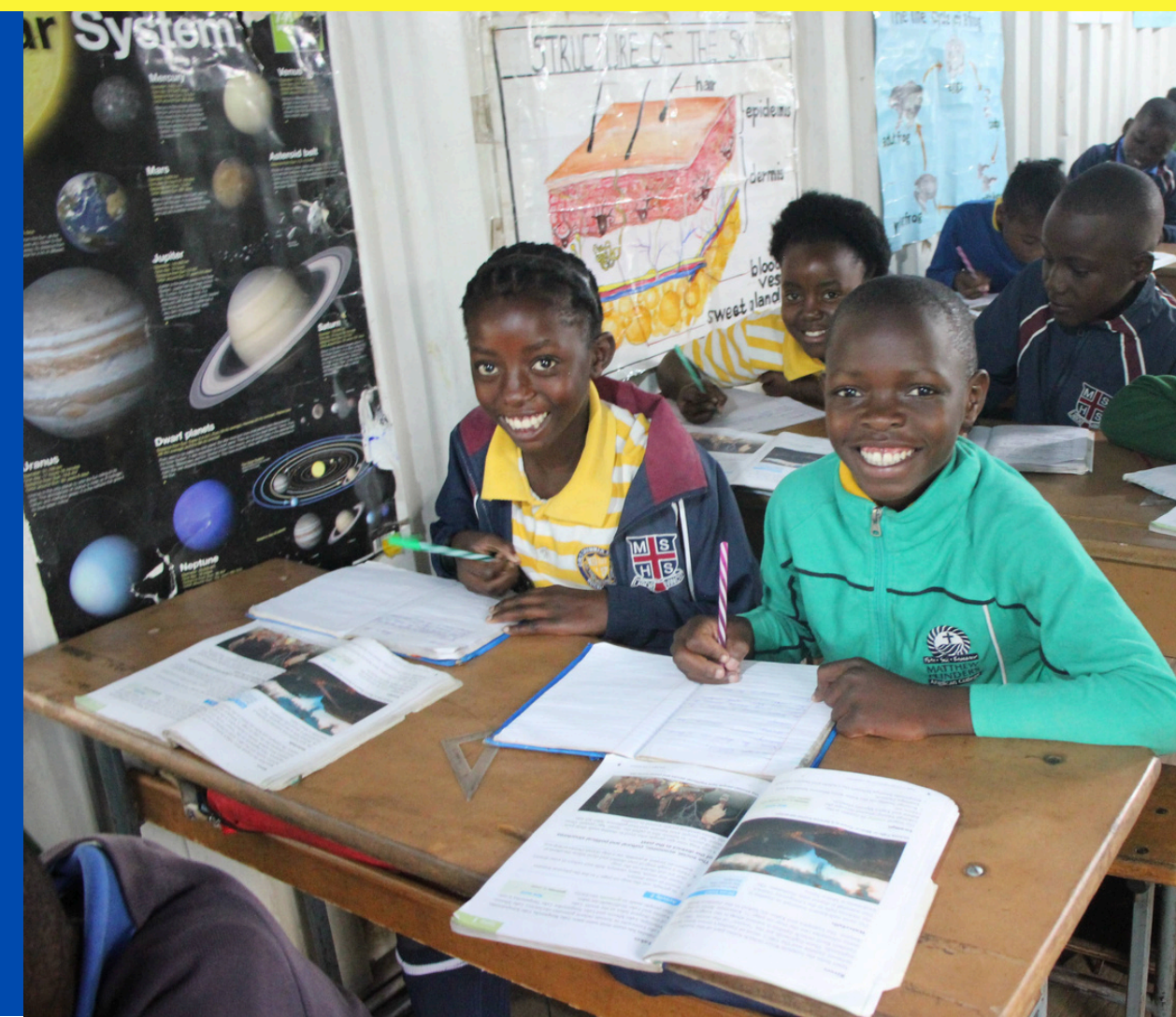
